The Holy Spirit, along with Jesus, is seen all the way back in Genesis 1:26-28:

We shall make man in our own image (Trinity in Gen 1:26-28).

Only Believers have the Holy Spirit.

The Holy Spirit:

Convicts

Nevertheless, I tell you the truth. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you. ⁸ And when He has come, He will convict the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: ⁹ of sin, because they do not believe in Me; ¹⁰ of righteousness, because I go to My Father and you see Me no more; ¹¹ of judgment, because the ruler of this world is judged.

John 16:7-11

The Spirit convicts us of our sin (both as Unbeliever coming to repentance and Believer) and shows us the way.

The Believer knows when they are out of step with the Spirit. Praise the Lord for conviction!

Comforts

Gives us Courage

Is our Advocate
