Recap, the last three weeks:

Discipleship pathway

While God is growing us He is moving us out in to obedience. We should always be listening to see what "next step" the Lord would have us take.

Move - We will be an encouraging people.

It's to profit all (1Corinthians 12:7 - for the building up/adding on)

It's God's plan (1Corinthians 12:11)

As a part of the body, we <u>need</u> each other (1Corinthians 12:12-14)

Encouragement Accountability The good and the <u>bad</u> When we <u>fail</u> to do our part inside of God's Church, the whole body suffers (1Corinthians 12:15-26), not to mention unbelievers.

What if everyone served, gave and loved like I do in God's Church, what would God's Church look like?

God never call us to be consumers, rather to be servers and followers.

Yet it shall not be so among you; but whoever desires to become great among you, let him be your servant. Matthew 20:26

He wants us to be obedient to the Head of the Church and that's not me, it's the Lord.

Giving time and energy, money, knowledge and abilities.

Work faithfully as if of the Lord. (Col 3:23-24 and Eph 6:5-8)
